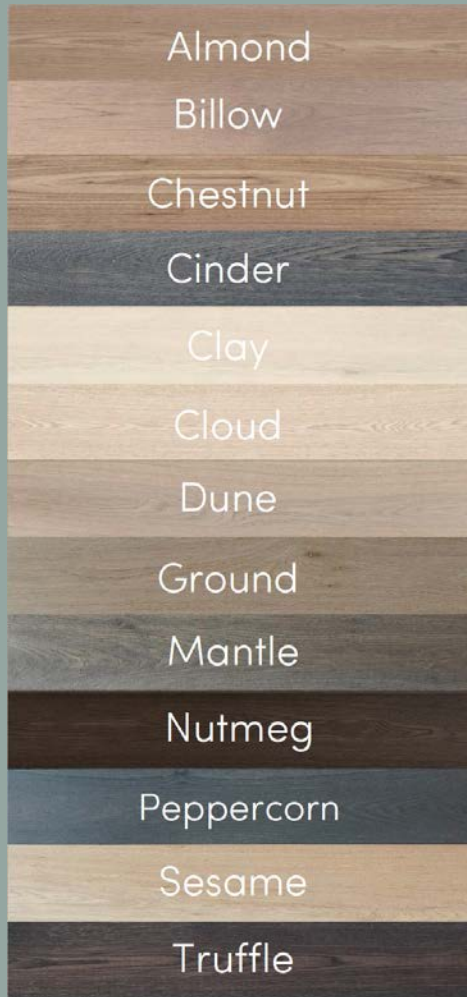

Suitable products



for Storey oiled floors

WOCA Natural Soap: This natural product is used for general cleaning of the floor. This soap and oil mixture allows you to maintain your floor while cleaning it. WOCA also offers a pre-mixed spray for spot cleaning.

WOCA Oil Refreshing Soap: This product is used regularly for natural oiled floors. You may also use this product to refresh your UV/Hard wax oiled floor, but only after years of wear and tear.

WOCA Maintenance Gel: This oil is quick-drying and leaves an attractive, water and dirt-repellent surface. This product is for the care and maintenance of oiled indoor wooden surfaces and floors.

General cleaning instructions



using WOCA Natural Soap

1. Shake Natural Soap carefully before use.
2. 125ml Natural Soap is mixed into 5 litres of lukewarm water. It is recommended always to work with two buckets; one with soap water and one with water for rinsing.
3. Clean the floor with minimal water. Leave soapy water on the floor briefly in order to dissolve dirt.
4. Remove dirty soap water with hard wrung out mop or cloth and rinse out in rinsing bucket.
5. Always wipe the floor with soap water with a hard wrung out mop or cloth in order to re-establish the protective Natural Soap film.

Important: weekly usage is highly recommended

Revitalising solution for quarterly cleaning



using WOCA Oil Refresher Soap

1. Shake the bottle well before use.
2. The floor must be free from dust before treatment.
3. Mix 125ml Oil Refresher into 5 litres of water.
4. Treat with a light wrung floor cloth or mop lengthwise of the floor.
5. For best results, use two buckets: one with the soap and water solution and a second with clean water to rinse the dirty mop.
6. Leave floor to dry for approximately two hours before use.

Maintaining your floor



using WOCA Maintenance Gel

1. Remove surface dirt with clean water, then leave to dry for at least 8-9 hours.
2. Apply an appropriate amount of gel to a red or white buffing pad and distribute over the surface in a thin, even coat. Continue polishing until the wood seems saturated and the surface has a uniform appearance. It is recommended to work on small areas at a time, as the gel is quick/drying.
3. Immediately wipe down the polished surface with a clean, dry lint-free cotton cloth.
4. Wait 4-6 hours before using the surface. Avoid getting water or dirt on the wooden surface for the next 2-3 days.

Suitable products



for Storey lacquered floors

WOCA Master Cleaner: Used frequently for the general cleaning of lacquered floors.

WOCA Master Care: This product is used once a year to refresh your lacquered floor. This product strengthens and prolongs the life of the surface as it protects against wear, tear and scratches.

WOCA Intensive Cleaning Spray: This is a unique ready-to-use-spray for the all-round cleaning of all interior wood work such as furniture, staircases, doors, panels and worktops independently, whether the surfaces are oiled, waxed or lacquered. It provides excellent cleaning, removes the most difficult dirt, grease and stains, and is fast and easy to apply.

General cleaning instructions



for WOCA Master Cleaner

1. Mix 125ml Master Cleaner with 5 litres of water for regular cleaning.
2. Wash the floor lengthwise. It is recommended to work with two buckets – one with solution and one for rinsing.
3. It is recommended to use as little water as possible for the cleaning and make sure that no water is left on the surface after.

Weekly usage is highly recommended

Maintenance of your lacquered floors



for WOCA Master Care

1. Wash the floor thoroughly with WOCA Master Cleaner. Wash with clean water afterwards.
2. Leave the floor to dry completely before application of Master Care.
3. Shake the container well before use.
4. Apply the concentrated care product in a thin and even coat, using a cotton cloth or dampened spray mop. If the cloth/mop becomes dirty, rinse in clean water and wring thoroughly. Then continue the application. Do not apply additional Master Care once a surface has begun to dry.
5. Leave the floor to dry for 1–2 hours.

Targeted cleaning



for WOCA Intensive Cleaning Spray

1. Shake bottle thoroughly.
2. Spray the Intensive Cleaner onto the surface.
3. Leave solution to dissolve affected area.
4. Wipe surface dry with a firmly rug cotton cloth.
5. Allow surface to dry.
